# IN THE COURTS

We have a strong legal team ready to fight for civil liberties. We are involved in 20 to 25 cases across Minnesota at any given time.

# **VOTING RIGHTS**

We are suing to restore the vote to more than 52,000 Minnesotans.

#### **IMMIGRANT RIGHTS**

We are challenging the detention of people unlawfully held for Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).

## **RACIAL JUSTICE**

We are challenging Faribault's "crime-free" housing ordinance that discriminates against immigrants and people of color.

#### **FIRST AMENDMENT**

We won cases that reinforced the right to protest police violence and to record police making arrests.



We educate, engage and activate communities to help inform them about their rights and mobilize to create change.

#### **SMART JUSTICE**

As part of the ACLU's national campaign to decrease mass incarceration, we are working with community groups, prosecutors and judges to hold warrant forgiveness days, reform bail practices and reduce racial disparities.

#### **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS**

Your rights are helpful only if you know what they are. We offer Know Your Rights trainings for activists, students and community members. We also table at events and festivals across the state.

Our Greater Minnesota Racial Justice Project is dedicated to advancing immigrant rights in rural areas through litigation and organizing.



We defend and advance civil liberties at the Capitol, and connect our supporters with their legislators.

#### **PRIVACY PROTECTIONS**

We are fighting to require law enforcement to get a warrant before using drones for surveillance, locating your cell phone or searching your email.

## **CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM**

We are working to reduce racial disparities and reform wealth-based justice by ending excessive fine and fees, supporting probation caps, and changing our forfeiture system to stop "policing for profit."
